### ENTRY FORMS AND FEES

1. This is a hobbyist show (ie: Koi owned by Koi hobbyists and taking possession of the Koi at the conclusion of the show) and will be conducted English style where each entrants fish are kept together in their own tank(s).
2. All owners must submit the signed entry / ownership form and paid the balance of all fees by Friday 5 PM.
3. Checks or money orders should be made payable to **AKCA**. Tanks will not be reserved nor will Koi be accepted until payment is received.
4. **Preregistration and fees must be postmarked no later than January 26<sup>th</sup> 2009.** The **\$45** entry fee includes the first 3 fish entered. Each additional fish will be \$5. Entry fees include as many tanks as necessary to safely hold your fish. No tank will be stocked beyond the 100% load as determined by the calculations shown on the entrant worksheet. Supplemental entries (made after the initial fish entries have been checked in) are \$10 per fish. Registration after January 26<sup>th</sup> is \$65 for the first 3 fish entered plus \$5 for each additional koi on a first come first served basis with no guarantee a tank will be available.
5. Entrants may, by mutual agreement, share a tank.
6. Each entrant is responsible for providing a net for use only with their tank. If you do not have your own net, please make arrangements to purchase one at the show from one of the vendors.
7. KCSD will provide a separate tub for use with each tank.

### ENTRANT REQUIREMENTS

1. This is a hobbyist only show. All Koi entered must be owned by and accompanied by the registered entrant. Koi dealers, even part time or informal fish dealers are not allowed to show fish. Koi dealers may assist their customers by transporting Koi to the show for them; however, **the actual owner of the Koi must be present no later than Friday 5 PM to sign the official entry/ownership form at the registration desk in order to qualify to receive awards.** If a winner is found to be in violation of this ruling, any and all awards will automatically be forfeited. This policy is intended to prevent any misperceptions regarding the integrity of the Koi dealers we all depend upon.
2. Past Grand Champions: We've make a change for our past KCSD Grand Champion winners to allow those back to our show that have not won within the last two years. If you have a KCSD Grand Champion from 2006 or before.....bring 'em back! A two year lapse shows your skills as a hobbyist to maintain the beauty of a past KCSD Grand Champion.

## PRE-SHOW PREPARATIONS

1. For the protection of your Koi, feeding should be discontinued for a minimum of 5-7 days prior to the show.
2. Be sure that your Koi are in good health. Koi with any signs of sickness or parasites will be disqualified. Look your fish over carefully top to bottom before you bring them. Fish that have ANY visible signs of injury, parasites or illness should not be transported to the show site. This will include any signs of areas that are not completely healed. The decision of the Show Chairman will be final in this matter.

## SHOW OFF YOUR NEW PURCHASE

Be sure to visit the Koi Vendors prior to close of registration on Friday to find, purchase and enter your new gem into the show. Each koi vendor has the option to reserve a show tank for the koi that you purchase from them at the show. These tanks are only for koi purchased at the show and we will not allow any mixing of koi in these tanks from any other source. There will be a \$5 entry fee for each koi entered. **Please DO NOT add any koi into these tanks. These are community tanks and new fish can only be placed into the tank by the dealer that sold you the koi.** Just inform the vendor at the time of purchase that you would like to enter your new koi into the show. Please make sure you are able to transport your new koi home and you must be present at the conclusion of the show Sunday afternoon to identify and take your new koi home.

## DELIVERY AND REMOVAL OF KOI

### We will NOT allow any arrivals on Saturday

1. Check-in of Koi will be available on Thursday between 8 AM and 6 PM and Friday between 8 AM and 5 PM. Late arrivals after 5 P.M. Friday will neither be accepted nor judged.
2. Each entrant will be assigned a number according to sequence of arrival.
3. Each entrant must remain with their Koi until the Koi are released into their tank(s). Owners also must be present during the benching, and classification. Entrants having multiple tanks may designate which of their fish go into which tank as long as the tank load criteria is maintained.
4. Digital photos will be taken of each fish during benching at no charge.
5. All Koi will be handled only by the Show Chairman's designated handlers.
6. All entries must be left on exhibit for the duration of the show until 3 PM Sunday. If you live more than 200 miles from the show site and need to leave early, please contact the Show Chairman, **PRIOR** to entering for approval.
7. All necessary precautions will be taken by the club to safeguard entered Koi including 24 hour monitoring. Therefore, all participants in the show will agree to hold the club, its officers, and members blameless against any loss or injury to the fish. Anyone wishing to inspect their Koi must contact the Show Chairman or a designee.
8. At the close of the show, Sunday 3 PM, each participant will be polled to ensure that all their fish are in their assigned tank(s). **All entrants must be present at that time to gather and claim their Koi.** Even though no fish should have been moved out of their assigned tanks, no Koi will be allowed to be bagged or removed until all fish are identified to the satisfaction of all entrants, and officially released by the Show Chairman. Out of towners will be given priority for fish removal and KCSD members will assist them as desired. Oxygen, bags, and rubber bands will be provided and freshly treated transport water will be available.
9. Any Koi not claimed at the conclusion of the show will become the property of KCSD.

## JUDGING

1. Prior to judging, the Show Chairman will verify that all of the Koi are entered in their proper class and size. If an error is made, corrections of classification will be made prior to or during judging, if it is possible without disrupting the flow of the show. This will not include optional classifying of gin rin or doitsu. The class placement decision on gin rin and doitsu must be made by the entrant at the time of benching, rather than after viewing the competition.
2. During the judging:
  - a. Efforts will be made to allow participants to listen to the judges comments. However, all participants and spectators must refrain from communicating with the judges. As in golf, quiet is required in the judging area.
  - b. All inquiries should be directed promptly to the Show Chairman.
3. The decisions of the Judges and the Show Chairman are final.

## CLASSES AND SIZES

1. SIZES: There will be eight class sizes, starting with Under 8", then 8-12", and the following sizes will run in three inch increments with the largest size being Over 27". There are no size limitations of either too small or too large. All sizes will be represented for every class.
2. HARIWAKE: Hariwake will be judged in the Hikari Moyo class.
3. GIN RIN: There will be two Gin Rin classes – A (Gosanke and Utsuri), and B (all others). Koi with Kin Gin Rin markings may be entered in either the Gin Rin category or the appropriate non-Gin Rin Category. Please note on your entry form your preference and be present at Koi check-in, to confirm proper placement. Please place gin rin in their designated class. Placing koi based on competition is considered in poor taste and discouraged. No changes can be made after the decision at check-in.
4. DOITSU: The entrant has the choice of entering the fish in either the Doitsu or appropriate regular class except for Shusui which must go in Asagi/Shusui, Kumonryu which must go in Kawarigo and those classified to go into the Hikari Moyo class. Please place Doitsu koi in the Doitsu class. Placing koi based on competition is considered in poor taste and discouraged. No changes can be made after the decision at check-in.
5. LONG FIN: Long fin is now a variety just like Doitsu or Gin Rin. The tail of a Long Fin will be included in the length measurement. All varieties will be judged in one class.
6. NOVICE ENTRIES: To qualify, the owner of the Koi cannot have previously competed in any Koi show. Novice will compete in the open class and, in addition, Novice awards will be presented for Novice Champion, Best Novice Mature (Over 21"), Best Novice Young (12" to 21"), and Best Novice Baby (under 12"). To Compete in Novice, the Entrant Must note novice status on the Entry form.
7. BEAUTIFUL TANK AWARD: An award will be presented for the most beautiful collection of koi in one show tank. This will, of course, be very subjective, intended to highlight the great variety and beauty of koi
